- ___ MIRRORS At least one securely mounted rearview.
- ___ BRAKE LIGHTS Functional.
- ___ BRAKES- Check for sufficient Linings or pads. Check condition of rotors and brake lines. *Start with fresh pads and bring an extra set with you.*
- ___ BRAKE FLUID - Check level. Change within 90 days of event.
- ___ BATTERY - securely fastened no leaks or corrosion.
- ___ DRIVE BELTS - Tight and in good condition.
- ___ LEAKS - No leaks of any kind, oil, gas, brake, or coolant.
- ___ RUST - No structural rust or damage to brakes or suspension.
- ___ SEAT BELTS - Original factory installation in good condition, no frayed or torn belts. Five point harness recommended.
- ___ THROTTLE RETURN - Check linkage and return springs.
- ___ SUSPENSION - No excessive looseness in steering or suspension. Ball joints in good condition, tie rods secure. CV boots in good condition. All mounting bolts secure.
- ___ WHEEL BEARINGS - Check for proper lubrication.
- ___ EXHAUST - No excessive smoke. working muffler in place.
- ___ WHEELS -No cracks or bends, check lug nut torque.
- ___ TIRES - No cracks or bulges, minimum 3/32" tread depth, HR or better rated. Spare removed or secured.
- ___ GAS

(At the track):

- ___ INTERIOR - Remove all loose objects, including glove box contents.
- ___ WINDSHIELD - No horizontal or vertical cracks. Chips are ok.
- ___ SIDE WINDOWS - Front side windows must go down (unless Lexan)
- CAP Gasket - intact and cap tightened
- ___ EQUAL RESTRAINTS – Two seats with equal restraints for passenger and driver.
